Question 1: Describe two features.... 4 marks

1 mark for feature + 1 mark for description
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Question 2a: How useful are Sources A and B for an enquiry into...? 8 marks

One paragraph on each source, both paragraphs to:

- mention what the source says
- relate what the source says to the enquiry question
- mention what the source miss out on about the enquiry question
- evaluate the source's NOP to see if it affects it's usefulness

No overall judgement needed on which is better, just individual judgements for each source.

Students will be given prompts as follows:

- Detail in Source that I would follow up.....
- Question I would ask.....
- What type of source I could use.....
- How this might help answer my question.....

Question 2b: How could you follow up Source to find out more about...? 4 marks

- 1), Look at the source and circle/underline a detail want know more about
- 2) Think of a question
- 3) Identify another source they could use, eg a diary, army records, doctors journals
- 4) Explain how the other source might help answer the question.

SECTION B: Medicine in Britain c1250 to present

Question 3: Explain one way in which ... was slimier/different in [time period] and [time period].... 4 marks.

This question is asking you to explain why people did something in a *similar* or *different* way in *two different* time periods. 4 marks so just one **PEEL**.

P- which factor explains the question? *One reason..... is similar/different is because of.....*

E- what piece of evidence supports the factor? *For example.....*

E- how does your evidence support your point? *This means...*

L- link back to the question, summarising your point. *This shows...*

Question 5/6: Statement. 'How far do you agree?' Explain your answer. 20 marks (16+4SPaG)

Question 4: Explain why there was much change/stayed the same in [topic of medicine] in the [time period].... 12 marks

Again this is an explain why question. Same focus on factors. You will be also given two stimulus points- don't have to use these, **but must use own knowledge**.

3 **PEEL** paragraphs- 3 factors + brief conclusion

P- which factor explains the question? *One reason.....changed/stayed the same is because of.....*

E- what piece of evidence supports the factor? *For example.....*

E- how does your evidence support your point? *This means...*

L- link back to the question, summarising your point. *This shows...*

In conclusion, there was much change/stayed the same due to....

Choice of two questions- pick one.

You will be given a statement in quotation marks and asked to reach a judgement on how far you agree with it. Again, you'll be given two-stimulus points, don't have to include- but must **use own knowledge**.

Paragraph 1- Support the statement using PEEL. Try to have 2 pieces of evidence- remember to explain them both.

Paragraph 2- Counter the statement using PEEL. Try to have 2 pieces of evidence- remember to explain them both.

Conclusion:

1. Judgement- make a judgement using words of the question (do you agree or disagree with the statement) *In conclusion I agree/disagree that.....to an extent.*

2. Counter- show that you are aware of counter argument with piece of evidence. *Although,...*

3. Support- support your judgement. *However,...*
