Year 11 Students: Arrangements on and from Friday, 14 June, 2019

For the majority of Year 11 students their last GCSE Examination, Physics, takes place at 9.00 am on Friday, 14 June, 2019.

Those students for whom this is their last GCSE examination will be leaving the School site at 11.45 am following their Physics examination.

However, for those students who have yet to complete all their GCSE examinations they **should continue to attend, in full school uniform, revision sessions and Walking/Talking Mocks, which apply to them, as detailed below, until all their examinations are finished.** Students taking Film Studies will not be permitted to leave at 11.45 am, following their Physics examination, as they are required to be in School.

Students remaining for their Film Studies GCSE examination revision session who wish to have their school shirt signed by fellow students and staff, must ensure that they bring into school with them a spare clean shirt which they will need to change into once their shirt signing is complete.
