**Re: Non-School Uniform Day – Friday, 25 October 2019 for Havens Hospice**

This Year it has been decided that the School's chosen charity will be Havens Hospice. With this in mind, we are taking part in the 'Hares about Town' campaign, which the hospice is running across the local community.
