Dear Parent/carer

Community testing is the way we are going to prevent the spread of COVID-19 as we start to return to normality following the "roadmap to recovery".

Step 1 begins during the week commencing 8 March, when schools fully open and wrap around childcare resumes. If successful, and the spread of COVID-19 through testing is prevented, the second stage of step 1 begins on 29 March, where the rule of 6 outdoors, along with outdoor sport can restart.

Steps 2 and 3, if successful, will lead to Step 4 no earlier than 21 June, where life is almost back to normal.

Community testing is starting in schools, but it is intended that we will all eventually test at home every week.

The testing programme for students in schools is part of the training of our young adults to carry out testing effectively. As such, young adults are expected to carry out 3 LFD (Lateral Flow Device) tests.

At Southchurch High School, we have arranged that your son's or daughter's 1st test may be carried out at a site within our local community. The nearest site to Southchurch High School is located at Garon's Sports Centre, but other sites may be booked if you prefer. Trained testers will facilitate the testing to help your son or daughter learn how to perform the test.

Their first test may be booked from 8:00am on Tuesday 2 March, (please see details below).

Your son's or daughter's 2nd test may be carried out at Southchurch High School and their 3rd test either at school or a testing site. (More details will be given nearer the time). Testing will then continue at home.

Please **do not** book or turn up for a test at the LFD sites if:

- You have any symptoms of Covid-19 (a high temperature, a new continuous cough, or loss or change to your sense of smell or taste)
- You have had a positive test (LFD or PCR) in the last 90 days
- You have been in contact with anyone in the last 10 days who has symptoms or tested positive

You may book online using the link below. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult. If not using the booking system and you are not accompanying your son or daughter please write a short note of consent for them to carry.
