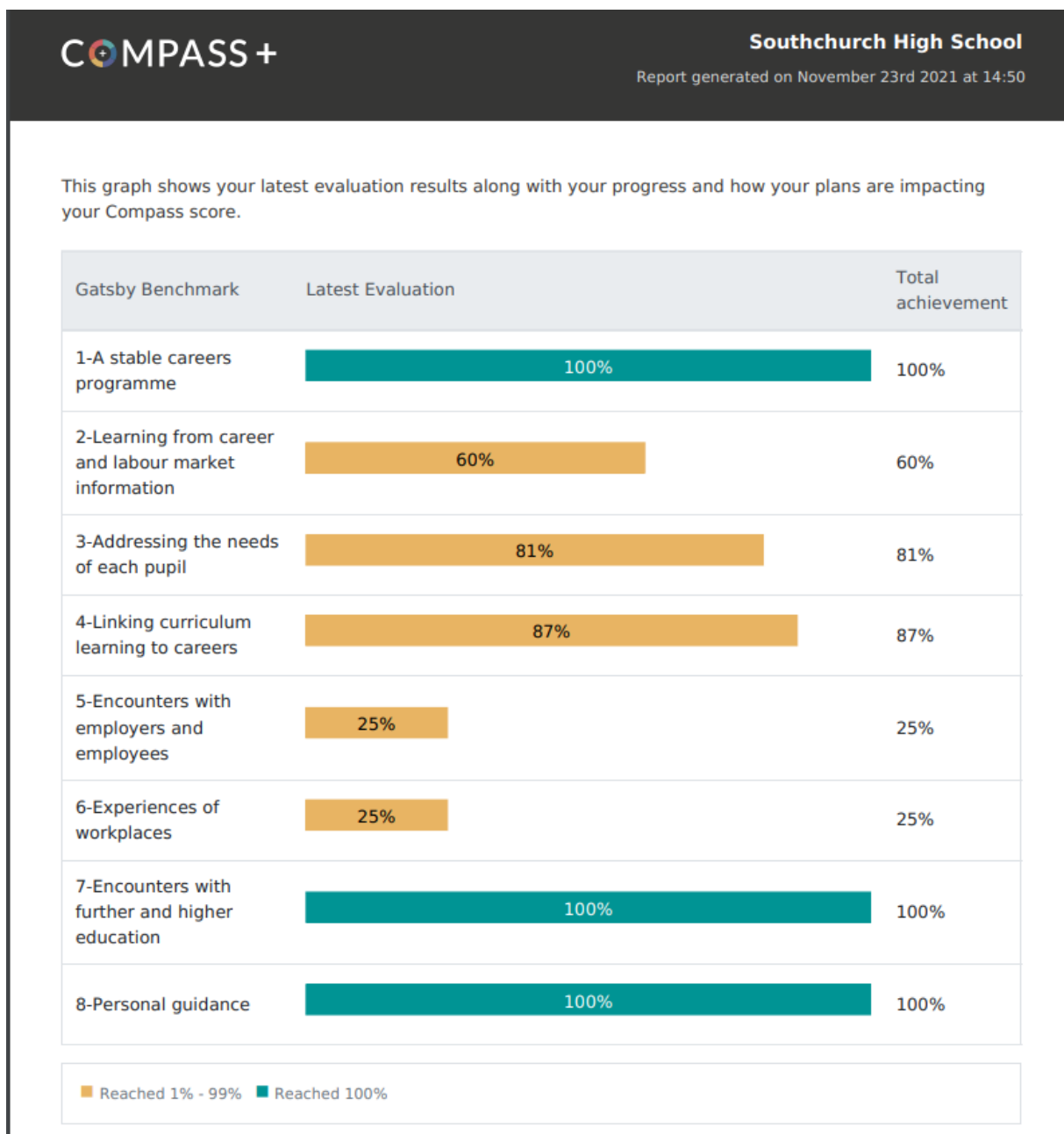


## The Impact of our Careers Program

Below is some feedback from a few of our most recent activities.

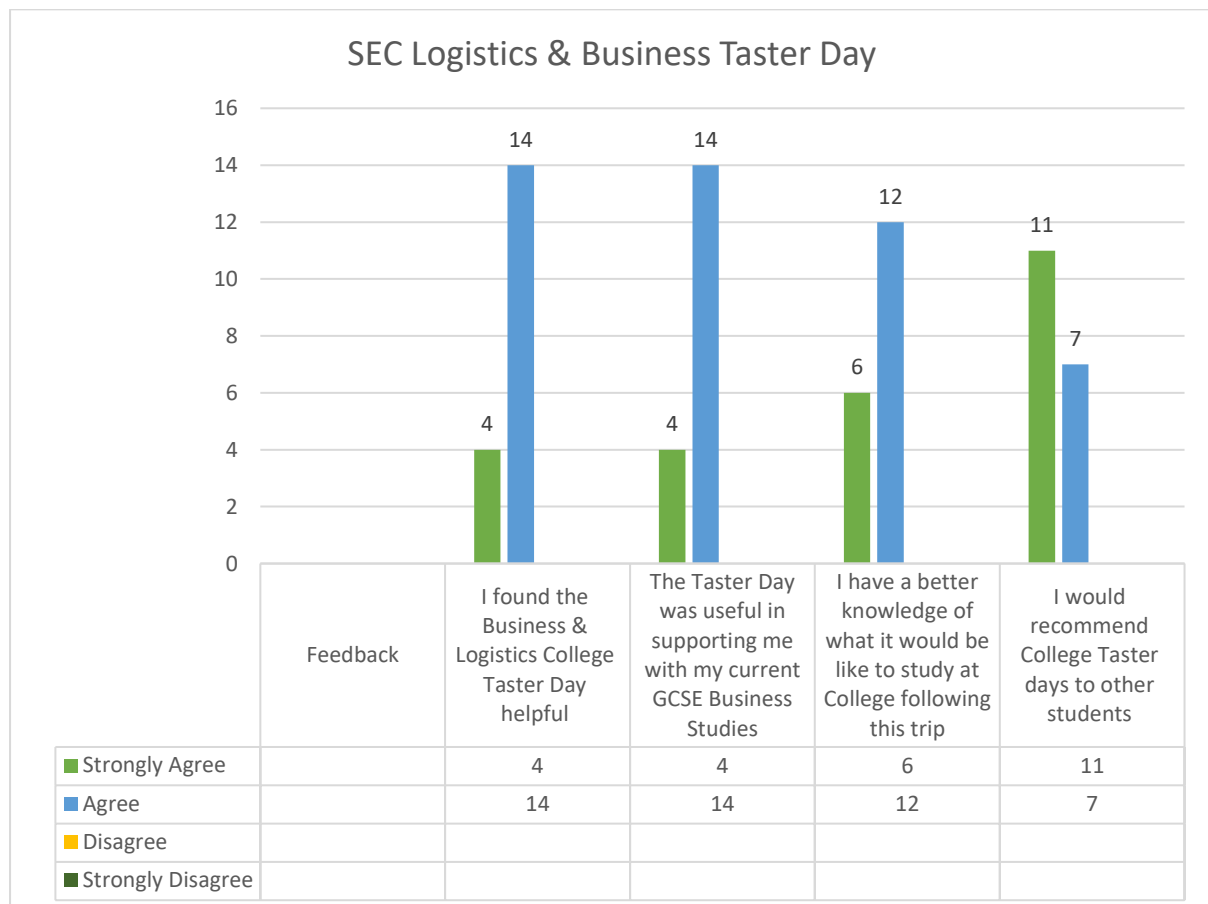
**Year 8 Choosing your Options Workshop**

“It helped me to understand what subjects I may have to study in order to achieve my future career goals”

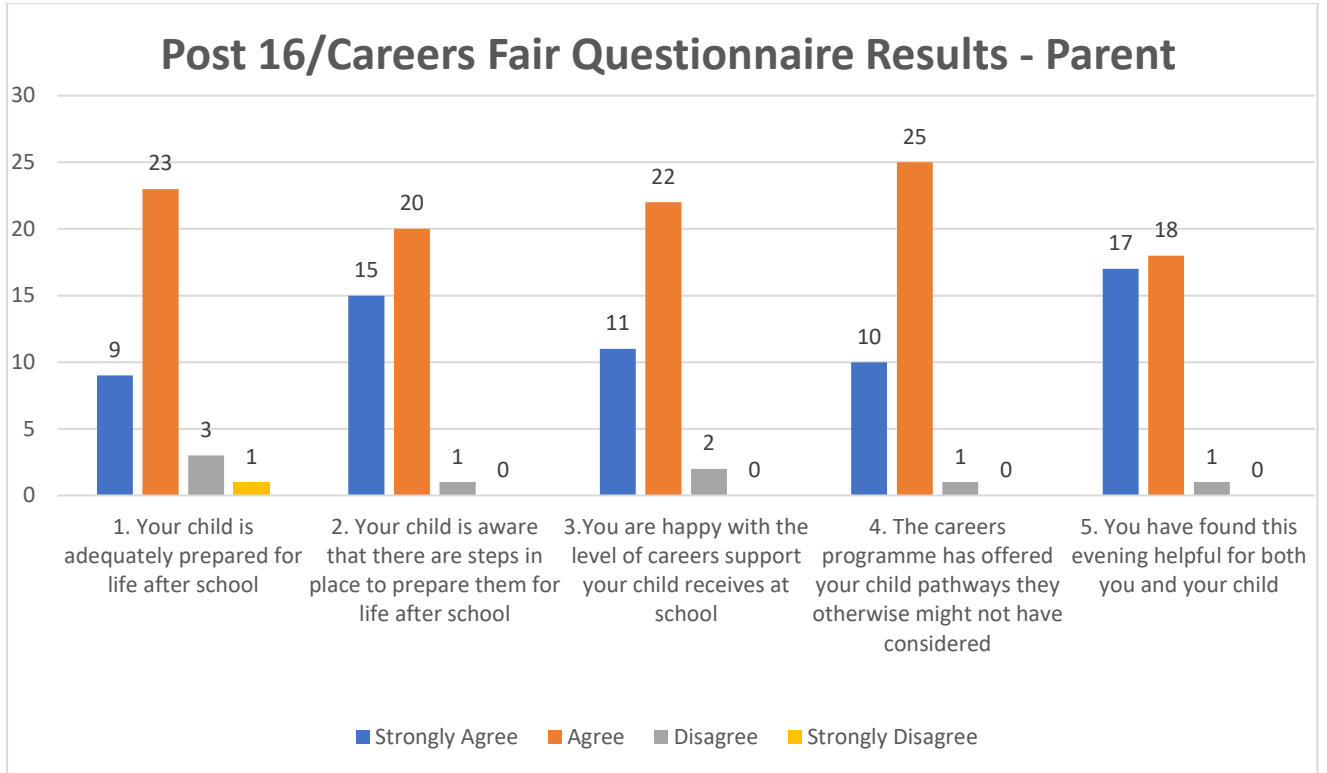
