What does this course involve at Key Stage 3?

We inspire all our students, whatever their starting point at KS3, to engage in learning activities and develop their knowledge of the language in a range of topics. We promote independent learning and progression for all, giving each student the best chance of success. We use resources, which make language relevant to students and provide a real insight into life in the French-speaking world. Finally, we use a systematic approach to language development in terms of grammar, pronunciation and study skills.

- > Say where you like to eat out; order food in a café
- Use quantities and understand recipes; numbers above 40
- > Talk about food specialities and art

- > Say what places there are in a town; describe a town
- > Say what you can do at different places
- > Ask for and give directions
- Arrange to go out and where to meet
- Identify and describe the location of places on a map
