Southend City Council manages the allocation of places following parent/carer applications during the Autumn Term. If your child is successful in their application, you will be notified in early March.

Please rest assured that any child who is offered a place at Southchurch High School will have the opportunity to spend time with us and participate in a full induction programme, including a Summer School. A very exciting time and a warm welcome awaits them.

Please see below a broad outline of the programme:

- April: Welcome Packs are sent to children who have been offered a place at Southchurch High School
- **June:** Individual parents/carers and the student are invited in for a transition meeting with a member of our Senior Leadership Team
- **July:** Induction Day
- August: Summer School takes place
